The aim of the event, which is organised by the Technology Centre CAS in cooperation with the European Commission and the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, is to present the programme, its achievements and impact on the researchers' careers as well as to encourage higher participation of Czech researchers and institutions. It will focus on promotion of the last calls in Horizon 2020 and will offer the outline of MSCA in Horizon Europe.
